The youth of Fisher Lutheran Church had an amazing trip in July to Flathead Lutheran Bible Camp near Whitefish, Montana. The Wilderness Adventure did not disappoint, and they were able to experience many new things that brought us closer to each other as a church community, closer to nature, and closer to God. The adventure began with a very early morning train ride. The group arrived at the camp late at night and woke up to the beautifully clear Flathead Lake and mountains, then prepared for

an overnight hike up Mount Aeneas in the Jewel Basin. All camping supplies had to be packed in backpacks, and the day was spent hiking, setting up camp, wading through slushy snow, and dipping in a 40 degree lake. There were also mountain goat visitors right in our camp, and no cell phone reception! The group participated in bible study with their counselors and evening worship by the lake. They played games and sports and were able to act as good role models for the younger campers. As a service project, they were asked to stain all the new outdoor benches. The camp staff was surprised at how well the group pulled together to get a job done well and quickly. The group got to try out a challenging high ropes course and ended the week with a white water
